This was a great way to end the year for our Lodge.








Fellow Knights,

# **Call to Annual Convention**

# Official Call to the One Hundred Thirty-Six Annual Sessions, Grand Lodge Knights of Pythias of Oregon

Newberg, Oregon August 20th, 2021

To all Subordinate Lodges, Past Grand Chancellors, Grand Representatives, Grand Officers and others interested.

Greetings: In accordance with the provisions of the Grand Constitution and Statutes, the One Hundred Thirty Sixth Grand Lodge, Knights of Pythias of Oregon will convene in legislative session at 11:00 AM on the morning of October 16th, 2021, at Damon Lodge #4 located in Pendleton, Oregon, said location having been chosen by the Grand Council.

Grand Lodge will convene in open session immediately after conferring of the Grand Lodge Rank, and every Pythian Knight in possession of the current semi-annual password is permitted to sit in the designated area of the hall during the Grand Lodge session when so evidenced by a notice at the outer door.

Delegates to Grand Lodge will need to have attained the Grand Lodge Rank. This rank will be conferred upon all Past Chancellors in good standing in their respective lodges, who submit a Past Chancellor Credential, at 11:00 AM, October 16th.

VOICE and VOTE in the Grand Lodge is accessible only to those as defined in Article II, Section 1 of the Grand Constitution. Those members of the Grand Lodge without voice and vote will be seated in a section of the Convention Hall designated for visiting members. (All members voice is important to us and your input is always welcome.)

We are looking for new ideas and involvement and what better way than to draw upon the talents of our new membership. It is our continuing goal to grow the order through membership involvement and to increase the communication back to our subordinate lodges.

#### **Restoring Talisman Lodge Membership and Building**

Over the last several years Talisman lodge located in Grants Pass Oregon, has fallen in disrepair, and losing membership. Oregon's Grand Chancellor Scott Swartout chose the rebuilding of Talisman's membership and repairing the lodge building as his Grand Chancellor's project. Scott assembled a team of knights from several lodges throughout Oregon to evaluate the building and identify the issues and formulate a plan to repair the problems found.

They found the roof leaking in both meeting rooms; attic vent screens missing, and electrical issues. The pump that supplied water from the lodge's well needed replace, and the septic system's drain field needed repaired.

The lodge members being young but active within the lodge didn't have the long-term leadership to rely on for help with the everyday activities, Scott enlisted several knights from seven other lodges to become dual members of Talisman lodge and willing to attend business meeting and help restore the lodge back to what it once was. Since all the dual members are over 200 miles away, it was decided to hold the monthly business meeting remotely with the local members. Plans were made to meet at the lodge every 3 months for a 3 to 4-day work party followed by an in-person business meeting.

During the work parties, members removed all the wallboard and debris along with the carpet. Another group inspected the roof, found damaged roofing causing the leaks and repaired the areas, they were able to install screens in the 8 attic vents to keep the owls out. Another team cleaned out an onsite storage building and helped remove the deconstruction material and acquired miscellaneous items, at the end of the day, we were able to fill a 30-yard dumpster and 5 pickup loads of items for donations. Work continued with preparing the ceiling joist for sheetrock, added more wiring for lighting, ceiling fan and wall outlets and switches. Sheetrock was installed, and ready for taping, texturing and painting. Several members kept busy trimming back the trees, shrubs, and debris from around the property. At the last work weekend as we were cleaning up the property, we had several neighborhood members stop by inquiring about the lodge and Knights of Pythias. We explained what the Knights are, how we 're involved within our communities. Three of the neighbors were impressed with our community involvement the work conducted at the lodge along with asked for an application for membership. So far, we received 1 application back for review.

Pythian Fun Day 2021

This year it is July 14th-18th



The Knights announced that the Fun Day in 2021 would be held at the Grande Springs Resort just outside of La Grande. Over the hill from La Grande is Baker City. Sites to see in Baker City include the Baker Heritage Museum with its impressive displays related to the gold mining history of the area. The Pythian Castle Hall may be available for a tour. This building is made from stone as are many of the historic buildings in Baker City. Baker City may have started for gold mining but it was built to stay. Just outside of Baker City is an Oregon Trail Interpretive Center. It has hiking trails that go down the same hill that the pioneers travelled. There are still parts of the original trail to be seen. It is truly the best Interpretive Center that I have seen! In the mountains just outside of Baker City is Sumpter, an early gold mining town. One of the main mining methods for the Sumpter area was dredging. Miles of tailing piles can still be seen. The dredge is still available to be viewed. Many Pythians and friends had a chance to see the dredge and ride the Sumpter Valley Railroad on the Pythian Day held in Baker City in 2011. One site to see on the La Grande side of the hills includes the Eagle Cap Excursion Train. It starts in Elgin and winds through the beautiful canyons to beautiful Wallowa Valley. Wallowa Valley was the homeland of Chief Joseph. Traveling by car to see Wallowa Lake and Eagle Cap Mountains would be a full day trip from La Grande. There is a tram that rises 3,700 feet and provides an expansive view of the Eagle Cap Wilderness. This area is considered the "Little Switzerland" of Oregon. Elgin also has an Opera House that was built in 1912. It has been beautifully restored and considered to be acoustically perfect. Plays and musicals can be seen here several times a year. This was just a movie theatre when I was growing up but since has been beautifully restored. And I should mention that the RV park is part of the Hot Lake Springs Resort. The building has had many functions through the years, including spa, nursing home and mental hospital. It is now a bed and breakfast and history center. There is also access to the soaking tubs that made Hot Lake a primary stop from the 1860's to the turn of the century.
